#### Sportscamp 2010 at Wadhams Hall

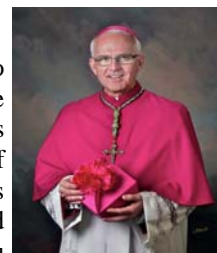
