Some of the original plans, (including lighting in the Cathedral, creating a baptismal area, repair to the Stations of the Cross, windows at Bishop Conroy, etc.), have been "on hold" while we continue to address extensive (and expensive!) stone work, both exterior and interior. There are still hundreds of thousands of dollars worth of work to be done to repair the exterior of the Cathedral, so I am especially grateful to all who continue to support our Capital Campaign.
