### Pilgrimage to Italy

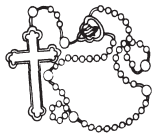
Most Rev. Terry R. LaValley will lead a pilgrimage to Catholic sites in Italy **March 12-23, 2012**. While at the Vatican, the group will take part in an audience with Pope Benedict XVI and visit St. Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel.
